- Figs can be grown outdoors in the UK, with Brown Turkey and Ice Crystal being the hardiest. All those we offer will produce a crop, without needing to produce flowers for pollination.
- They can be grown in containers, or if you want to plant it directly in the ground, it will produce a better crop if you are able to restrict its roots. I have done this by planting in a submerged container with good drainage holes, but you can also buy special 'root control bags' to plant them in. Without root restriction the plant tends to put most of its effort into producing foliage at the expense of fruit.
- Figs like a sunny location, and tolerate most soil types (They will need to be kept well watered while the fruit are developing. They can also be trained against a wall, especially in a fan-shape, which makes it easier to provide frost protection over winter if you live in a particularly frost-prone area.
