KIWI



- Kiwi 'Jenny' is the only self-fertile, hardy variety currently in cultivation. It is a vigorous vine, especially well suited to growing over a pergola or trained as an espalier. Once planted they will grow rapidly so make sure you are able to provide them with supports ready in place when you plant them.
- Kiwis grow best in a sunny and sheltered position, in a fertile soil, with a regular mulch of organic matter. They don't like being waterlogged though.
- The egg-sized fruit are ready for harvesting in September / October, and you can expect to harvest your own kiwi fruit within around 3 years of planting.
