STRAWBERRIES



- We offer several varieties of strawberries, namely early, mid and late season varieties. Their names and season are shown on their individual labels. As with any fruit plant, exactly when they will be ripe will depend on the weather and your care of them, but by growing the full range it will help you to enjoy that delicious 'just picked' freshness that you can't get from a supermarket.
- While you don't need to grow strawberries with a mulch of straw, it is worth the hassle because it makes it a bit harder for the slugs to feast on the fruit as it raises them off the ground, and secondly, the fruit will avoid getting muddy splash-back when rained on or watered.
- They can also be grown in hanging baskets, but make sure you use a good quality growing medium (not just multi-purpose compost) as the plants will last several years and need to be well fed to provide a good crop.
