CUCUMELON



 Cucamelons have been around for several years now. They look like grape-sized watermelons and taste of cucumber with a hint of citrus. They are incredibly easy to grow and produce a generous harvest of cucamelons. They can be left to trail, but I suggest training up a trellis, net or wigwam (like for runner beans) as it makes it easier to harvest.



- They don't require any flowers to be pinched out, and can be grown indoors or out, with the harvest being much greater under glass.
- Water well, as you would a courgette or cucumber, and grown in a fertile soil.
- What to do with them? Eat straight from the plant, add them to salads, pickle them, add them to deserts, the list is endless...

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
