

OREGANO



Oregano has small hairy leaves, and has white flowers. Both the leaves and flowers are edible, used in a wide range of dishes, especially in stews and casseroles. It is hardier than marjoram and slightly larger too. Oregano grows well in full sun and prefers drier conditions than marjoram. The leaves taste stronger in summer than in winter.

PARSLEY - CURLY



Parsley is a hardy herb, flowering in its second year. Afrodite is a tightly curled variety that is easy to grow. Parsley is a hungry plant and needs a good deep soil, preferably the soil having been previously manured. Parsley produces leaves all year round but may benefit from shelter during the colder months to keep cropping well.

PARSLEY - FLAT



Parsley is a hardy herb, flowering in its second year. Italian flat leaf parsley has large toothed leaves with a strong flavour. As with curly parsley, it is a hungry plant and needs a good deep soil, preferably the soil having been previously manured. It produces leaves all year round but may benefit from shelter to keep cropping during winter.

ROSEMARY



Rosemary is a hardy evergreen herb that has a very intense scent. The flowers are frequently pale blue but some varieties are pink or white. It prefers a well-drained soil in full sun, and will grow well in containers too. It is great added to roasted vegetables, and goes well when added to homemade breads. The pretty flowers are edible too
