CAULIFLOWERS



- We grow 2 varieties 'All Year Round' as the name suggests, it can be sown and harvested throughout the year - and 'Igloo' which can either be planted close together for mini-size cauliflowers, or wider apart for larger ones.
- As with any brassica, it can be susceptible to whitefly and butterfly problems in the warmer months, and bird damage during the colder months, so it may be best to protect your crop with fine netting.
- Spacing for cauliflowers depends on how big you plan on letting them grow, and also where you are growing them. If you grow in raised beds then you can plant them closer together, maybe 18" apart, but in open ground and for bigger cauliflowers, allow 24-30" between plants.
