BASIL

Basil is a classic ingredient in many Italian dishes, and there are many different varieties available, with Sweet Genovese being the classic variety that most people will be familiar with. Basil is very cold-sensitive and shouldn't be planted outdoors as it will not survive our summers. It should be grown either on a warm sunny windowsill or in a greenhouse. It can be planted in a bigger pot, or straight into the soil borders of a greenhouse. Pinch out the tip when several sets of leaves have grown as this will encourage the plant to bush out.
